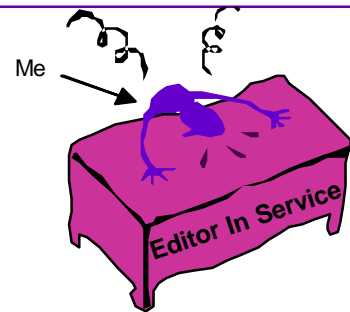

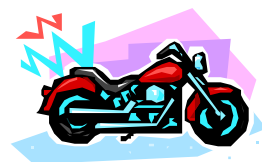
Dear Kindred Spirits ~
